

The twenty eighth 2019 hike for our Selkirk Cabinet Purcell Group (Wednesday, October 30th) will be a hike along Curley Creek to see the location of the old log flume. After that we will hike McClintock Loop, a road across the highway from Hemlocks. **No dogs** on this one.

Curley Creek is the creek that comes off Goat Mountain and goes from Perkins Lake past Herman Lake along old highway 2 and spills into the Kootenai near the Montana line.

McClintock Loop is a recent logging road that gives us a good view down to and across the river.

Total length of the hike should be about 7 or 8 miles.
