

Departure for fourth outing of the 2020 season next Wednesday June 3<sup>rd</sup> at **8:00AM** from Bonners Ferry Information Center Parking Lot across from the big flag. From there we will take separate cars and keep social distancing.

This year we will be using the Mission Peak Trailhead, so the hike will be a little over 3 Miles one way 6 Miles total. The first mile is a little steeper than a logging road, so we go slowly. After that it is not steep at all. Right click on the paths to see the elevations and see the exact steepness. So, I believe this is a good hike for those looking for an easier hike.

We will eat our lunches or snacks on top, then after the hike we will stop for an hour at [Round Prairie Mercantile](#) on US Highway 95, [22 miles north of downtown Bonners Ferry](#).

Above [Mission Creek](#) and up [Mission Creek Hall Mountain Road](#), [Harvey Mountain](#) is a long ridge ([ridge 1](#), [ridge 2](#) and [ridge 3](#)) that we will be hiking along the Canadian Border between [Hall Mountain](#) (another long ridge, [ridge 1](#) and [ridge 2](#)) and [Border or Hogue Mountain](#) (another long ridge) and [Eastport](#). Driving north, south of Bonners Ferry you begin to see what looks like a great range of Mountain across the North. You are actually looking at a shorter ridge (Long Shorty Ridge ([ridge 1](#) and [ridge 2](#)) with [Tungsten Mountain](#)) and these three East to West ridges on the north side of [Round Prairie](#). You will realize this as you get closer to Round Prairie and that great range of mountain disappears into only the shorter ridge. Hall Mountain Ridge turns north and ends up in Creston where its west side is very steep. From Harvey, we should be able to see [Northwest Peak](#) only 12 miles east. [Copper Mountain](#) and [Ruby \(Spruce Lake\) Mountain](#) are only three miles east. [Davis Peak](#), [Canuk Peak](#) and north end of [Buckhorn Ridge](#) (goes down to [Goat Mountain](#)) are also within 10 to 12 miles to the east. Area of [Bethlehem Mine](#) on [Buzzard Mountain](#) (2 miles away) may also be visible. Both the [Round Prairie](#) and [Moyie River](#) basins will be visible.

If any problem viewing these links, [download a free version of Google Earth](#) (GE) (Save those links when you exit GE to move them out of the temporary folder, then (if you want) right click to set up your own folder for this hike).
