

Scotsman Peak Hike | Cabinets

The eighteenth hike for the Selkirk, Purcell, Cabinet Group for 2020 will be to Scotsman Peak, very close to Clark Fork, Idaho in the Cabinets. Wednesday September 9th we will depart from the [Big Flag Information Center Parking Lot Bonners Ferry](#) at 8:00AM, then depart from [Samuels Store](#) 8:20AM, [Lower Pack River Road Hwy 200 Parking Lot](#) 9:00AM, and the [Clark Fork Chevron](#) at 9:30AM.

I have heard this is the classic hike. It is 4 miles one way, 8 round trip with an elevation gain of 3,800 feet. A slow pace and that steady effort is all that is needed to summit.

If you have yet to do so, download a free copy of Google Earth. Once you have Google Earth on your computer, just click on the link above and you will be able to see the hike.

From Sandpoint Idaho, head eastbound on Hwy 200 to the town of Clark Fork and look for the Chevron gas station on the west end of town. Turn north at the Chevron Station. Go one half mile to the fork in the road and then go right for another 2 miles to FSR #2294. Turn right and take FSR #2294 for another 1.4 miles to FSR #2294A. Turn left onto FSR #2294A and follow it a little less than 2 miles to the trailhead.
