

Simple Module Practice

Add a new word. Then add a new product type named after that new word.

Complex Module Practice

Add a new word. Then add a new product type named after that new word, and associate that product type to the new word. Then add a new product named after the new word, and associate that product to the new product type (named after the same new word). Then add a new Process, new Facility, new Customer, new Supplier, new Market, new Facility Activity, new Facility Asset, new Asset, or new Facility Event with the same word.

Simple Module Practice – New Product from New Word

Add a new word using existing form. Refresh the form.

Click on a control named New Product Control that starts an event procedure named New Product Type Event Procedure. New Product Type Event Procedure opens a class module named New Product Type Class Module that declares its purpose is to use the new word to create a new product type that is associated with the new word.

The function procedure for the New Product Type Class Module returns a new product type named after the new word.

The sub-procedure for the functions of New Product Type Class Module carry out the operation. Sub-procedures begin with a sub-keyword and end with an end-sub.
