

Conscience Law and Truth

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The purpose of this document is to relate Conscience, Law and Truth. The Bible describes the Law as the codification of what (before time began when we were designed) was written on our hearts. In other words, when we read the Law it rings true to our inner conscience. The Bible says that we were designed with the Law written on our heart. But that is not enough. We were also designed to need personal objective motivation from God written on our heart. The fact the Law rings true with our conscience, only leads us to realize that God reveals himself by faith through his relationship with only one man Abraham and one woman Mary. Through the faith of those two people we can come to Jesus where we can live in him, he in us, in truth, or in holy motivation.

Business Rules vs. Objectives

Neither the Law nor our conscience tells us what to do. They are just business rules by which we relate to each other. Like Abraham, to know our holy objectives we have to communicate personally with God. Like Abraham, we are designed to do what God motivates us to do. Besides those business rules, with the mystery of the Holy Spirit we get to personally have our strategic objectives written on our heart. And, those objectives will never violate those business rules. In other words, just like Jesus knowing and doing what the Father told him to do, we can know and do our calling (Jesus' objectives for us revealed and confirmed through prayer), and therefore live in the name of Jesus. So, our conscience rings true with the Law, and brings us to the only way to satisfaction, our personal relationship with Jesus.
