### Jobs with Current Volunteers:

#### Spring/Summer

- Mowing (cemetery, front and back of church): Petra, Bauck boys...all need to learn proper use of the riding mower including a few more volunteers
- Weed whacking (around headstones, mail boxes, sign posts of church, and other places as needed): Khouria Cindy...need a few more volunteers
- Water walnut trees (deep water ~ 10-14 days): Merv Anna
- Flower beds and pots in front of church (weeding, planting, watering): Gloria
- Weed spraying: Subdeacon Theophan
- Turn on water to drippers in cemetery: Subdeacon Matthew (will train others)
- Votives to be placed on graves before Palm Sunday and taken away after All Saints: Gloria
- Set program for water drippers: Subdeacon Matthew (will train others)

#### Fall

- Roll up hoses and put in shed: Petra
- Shut off water to cemetery and blow out drip lines (before it freezes): Subdeacon Matthew (will train others)

#### Ongoing

- Stake grave location before grave preparation: Subdeacon Matthew (Subdeacon Theophan and Baucks to learn)

### Jobs that need volunteers:

#### Spring/Summer

- Spray yellow jacket nests as needed
- Put out yellow jacket traps
- Arrange for gopher eradication (call 208-691-3881, please talk to Mary)
- Check all drippers to make sure working (Younger people)

- Pull weeds in mulched area under shrubs (inside & outside of cemetery fence)
- Put out vases w/ votives on gravel path for Pascha night & pick up & put in shed before Agape Vespers
- Fertilize Cemetery?
- Open (Spring) and close (Fall) foundation vents
- Put out pots, procure flowers, fill pots

### **Fall**

- Stake concrete parking bumpers in parking lot before it snows

### **Misc Jobs**

- Shovel walkway across front of the church – ramp and porch: as needed (Everyone)
- Purchase snow melt as needed

### **Notes**

- Weed spray: Milestone is expensive, but only need to use a little and is least toxic (Mary is expert on this topic). Suggestion: buy Weed Impede and add Milestone if any green showing around March... pre-emergent weed spray.
- Riding Lawnmower: Gayle advised Wally will donate a new riding mower to church. It needs about three people to learn how to use/maintain it. Last riding mower only lasted one season before became unusable. Need to add **harrow** to level ground (gopher holes).
