Bishop's Committee Meeting 2nd Tuesday, Sept 10th at 10:00AM

Church Growth and Development Committee of the Diocese of Spokane will grant funds this year. Because the Diocesan Foundation allocated funds last year, they are now available for distribution. In the first full week in September, Saint Mary's should be receiving complete information and application forms. Soon after that the deadline for applications will follow, so now is the time to think about any need we may have for a grant. Qualifying initiatives or programs must: a) be completed during the 12 months following the receipt of the funds; b) must be mindful of existing mission policies of the Diocese; c) must demonstrate a well defined goal and plan to achieve that goal; and d) must not include activities funded by the operating budget.
